

Jester's Day Camp

What is day camp?

Day camp is a great opportunity for girls to be active outdoors, make new friends, learn new skills and have a really good time while still being able to go home each night. The girls will be in units of 12-16 girls led by 2-3 adult volunteers. Adult volunteers are **extremely** important! Without you we couldn't run camp! **Volunteering is a great way to spend time with your girl in a wonderful environment and, as an added bonus; every full-time volunteer is allowed 1 child to go for free. Otherwise the fee for the week is \$190 if you register by April 15th, \$220 from April 15th to May 15th so please register early.** If you've been a unit leader before, you remember how fun it was and we hope to see you again. If you've never been a leader before, don't worry! We offer site trainings, information and activity packs, and anything else you would need. All you have to bring is a great attitude! Each unit will also have 2-3 caddies. Caddies are junior high and high school age girls who have gone through specific training to be at camp. The girls adore them and they're a fantastic resource for you as a leader. If you volunteer and have children too young to be in a unit, there is day care for \$40 a week per child and if you have a son there is also a boys unit run by women (or men) with Boy Scout experience for \$60 a week per boy. We try to make camp as easy on unit leaders as possible.

What is a typical day at camp like?

The girls will arrive at camp at 9:00am, spend the day swimming, doing crafts, playing outside, and meeting new friends. Lunch will be cooked in your unit over a fire so that everyone can participate in the meal. And, of course, snacks during the day! At 5:00pm the girls go home. Bus transportation is available and included in the camp fee. Thursday is a special day. The girls have the option to stay overnight at camp. Younger girls will stay in the various camp buildings while older girls get to stay in trail tents next to buildings.

Overall, just remember that camp is designed to give your child a great experience in a completely safe and organized environment.
