

# 2017 Caddie Information

## What is a Caddie?

Caddies are older girls who volunteer to work for the week at camp. This is a great opportunity to explore your leadership skills while having a great time with other caddies and the little campers. While a caddie is not an adult volunteer, she is still expected to take on certain responsibilities for herself and her unit. During the camp day, you will be assigned a specific unit. There are usually 3-4 caddies with each unit. Caddies help Unit Leaders with activities like cooking lunch and crafts, play games and sing songs with the girls, and generally help make camp fun for the girls. After the campers go home for the day there are fun activities planned for the evenings if you choose to stay the additional nights.

## Rookie Caddies

If this is your first year as a Caddie you are considered a Rookie. Rookies will be paired up and have different responsibilities from the more experienced Caddies. The reason we do this is to give you leadership experience and a chance to see how camp works. You will be assigned a unit, but will spend part of your morning and afternoon assigned to one of the activity stations at camp such as archery, daily crafts, kitchen pack out, mad science, etc. You will rotate through these stations on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday. Lunch will still be with your unit every day and you'll spend all day with your unit at the beach on Wednesday. You will also be with your unit for all Thursday night activities. ## Overnights

The entire camp will be staying overnight on Thursday. You are expected to stay as well. This can be a scary time for the girls and having you there will help them. Additional nights are optional. You can stay Sunday, Monday, and Wednesday night. Everyone goes home Tuesday night. Staying the extra nights is fun. You get a chance to hang out with the other caddies, do fun activities and crafts, and really get the full caddie experience. There is no additional fee for the overnights.

## Training

The only training you are required to attend is on **Sunday, June 18th from 2pm – 8pm**. This is the Sunday before camp starts. Training day is mandatory for any caddie who wants to work the week. Check in will be from 1-2pm. Training starts promptly at 2pm. You must be on time and attend the entire training to caddie for the week.

## Signing Up

You will need to fill out the Caddie Application, Behavior Contract, and Health Form. Please fill out all forms clearly. The fee for caddies is \$60 for the week.
